

ORDINANCE G-7173

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PHOENIX CITY CODE
CHAPTER 36, ARTICLE XI, SECTION 36-157.3 TO ADD
AREA 30 TO THE RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT
ORDINANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHOENIX as
follows:

SECTION 1. Sec. 36-157.3, Phoenix City Code, is amended to add:

Sec. 36-157.3. Permit areas.

AREA 30. AN AREA GENERALLY BOUNDED BY CAMELBACK FRONTAGE ROAD
ON THE SOUTH, 41ST STREET ON THE WEST, MEDLOCK DRIVE ON THE EAST,
AND WHERE 41ST STREET AND MEDLOCK DRIVE INTERSECT, INCLUDING THE
CUL-DE-SAC OF 41ST STREET, ON THE NORTH.

SECTION 2. Whereas, the immediate operation of the provisions of this
ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an
emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage by the Council as required by the City Charter and is
hereby exempted from the referendum clause of said Charter.
